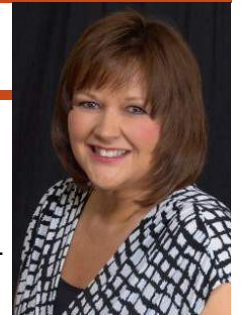

I supervise 2 office staff members and facilitate a class, The Life of Jesus Christ. A major part of my time is given to the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) for **Ladies Living Free** and **Paducah Lifeline**.

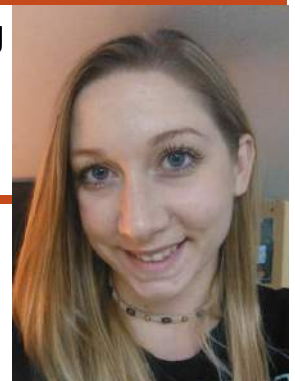

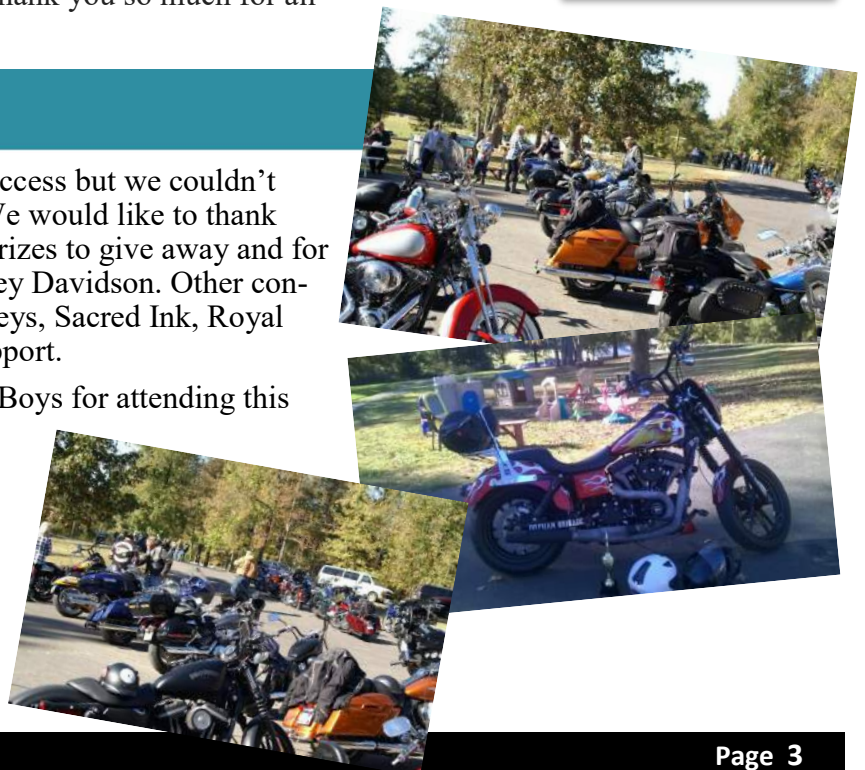
